The CUP girls/CDA Premier teams have a girls' team in every National League age group for 2017-2018 and a team in every premier division of the regional league. The club has a stated goal of getting players placed into quality college programs and in National teams, the club has a proven history of developing players that are continuously recognized by US Soccer, US Youth Soccer, US Club Soccer, and Collegiate programs across the country.

The CUP Girls Technical Director will report to the Club's Executive Director and/or the Board of Directors.

Qualifications:

Licensure: USSF "A" license, or, NSCAA equivalent, or, Foreign Licensure equivalent.

Playing Experience: College, or, equivalent required.

College Degree preferred.

Coaching Experience: Director of Coaching experience preferred, or, a minimum 10 years youth coaching experience, or, 5 years as Professional or College Head Coach.

- Ability to relate to and motivate youth and adults

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Recruit and assign qualified coaches in consultation with the Executive Director and Board
- Train and monitor coaches and help them plan and implement training sessions
- Coordinate club-wide training with Executive Director and DOC's
- Provide guidance to coaches on match management and how to interact with parents and club officials.
- Participate and direct age specific coach's clinics
- Organize skills clinics
- Create and coordinate a club-wide player development model from U11 to U21s with Executive Director & Girls DOC
- Bring in experts to assist in overall player development
- Identify most talented Girls players in club and alert State and Regional coaches for possible inclusion in State, Regional and National teams
- Coordinate with Executive Director and oversee tournament selections to ensure proper team and player development.
- Design and administer team tryouts
- Assist in the design of a parent education program
- Collaborate with Executive Director and CUP DOC's in the design of a college recruiting program and educate players and parents on college playing opportunities
